Re: Report on the operating result of the reviewed financial statements for the third quarter ended September 30, 2017.

Dear Sirs,

TPI Polene Power Public Company Limited (“the Company”) would like to report the operating result of the reviewed financial statements for the third quarter ended September 30, 2017 as follows:-

Total revenue from sales of power and goods and revenue from adders in Q3/2017 were Baht 1,143 million compared with Baht 898 million in Q3/2016, an increase of 27.33%, as the units of power sale in Q3/2017 increased. Total income in Q3/2017 was Baht 1,233 million compared with Baht 925 million in Q3/2016, an increase of 33.25%.

In Q3/2017, the Company registered profit for the period of Baht 593 million (or basic earnings per share of Baht 0.071) compared with profit for the period of Baht 284 million in Q3/2016 (or basic earnings per share of Baht 0.048), an increase of 108.76%. Profit for the period of Baht 593 million in Q3/2017 was comprised of normal operating profit of Baht 550 million and net foreign exchange gain of Baht 43 million whereas the profit for the period of Baht 284 million in Q3/2016 was comprised of normal operating profit of Baht 266 million and net foreign exchange gain of Baht 18 million.

For the first nine-month period of the year 2017, the Company registered profit for the period of Baht 1,998 million (or basic earnings per share of Baht 0.263) compared with profit for the period of Baht 1,420 million (or basic earnings per share of Baht 0.241) in 9M/2016, an increase of 40.70%. Normal operating profit in 9M/2017 was Baht 1,841 million compared with the same of Baht 1,330 million in 9M/2016, an increase of 38.41%.
